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Your Intercontinental Flight's Carbon Footprint

On a typical intercontinental flight, we emit the massive amount of 6,314 kg of greenhouse gases per person. This figure includes the entire lifecycle of the aircraft and its fuel consumption. We calculated this based on a return flight from Vienna to San Francisco at 9,640 km, quite a substantial distance, but still a common one.
